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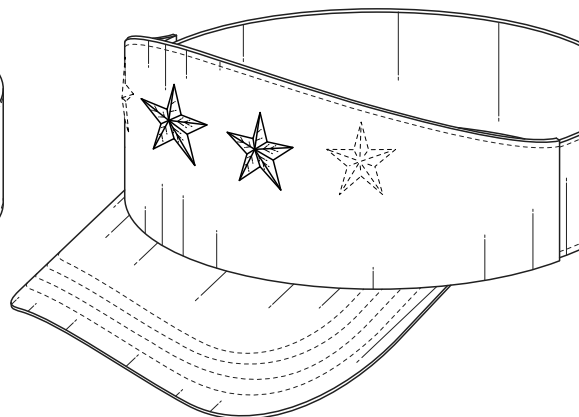
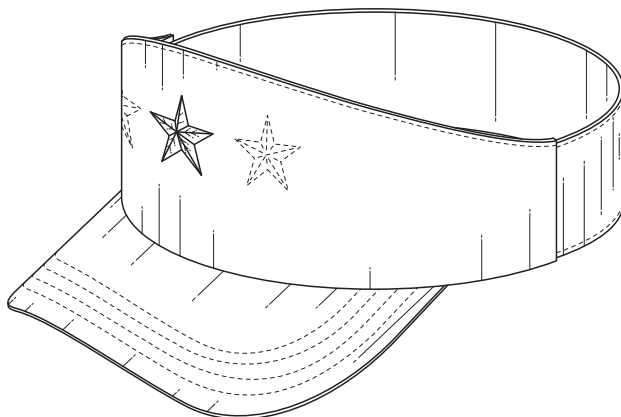
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a visor, showing a first embodiment of my new design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom perspective view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a right-side elevational view of FIG. 1, the left-side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 8 is a top perspective view of a second embodiment thereof;
FIG. 9 is a bottom perspective view of FIG. 8;

FIG. 12 is a right-side elevational view of FIG. 8, the left-side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

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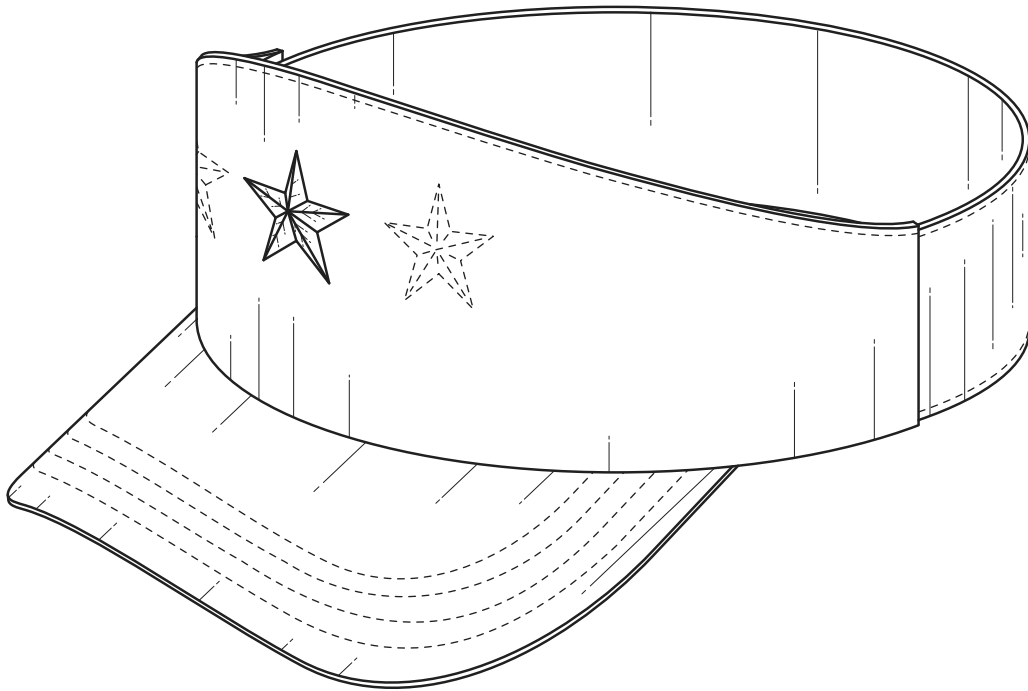

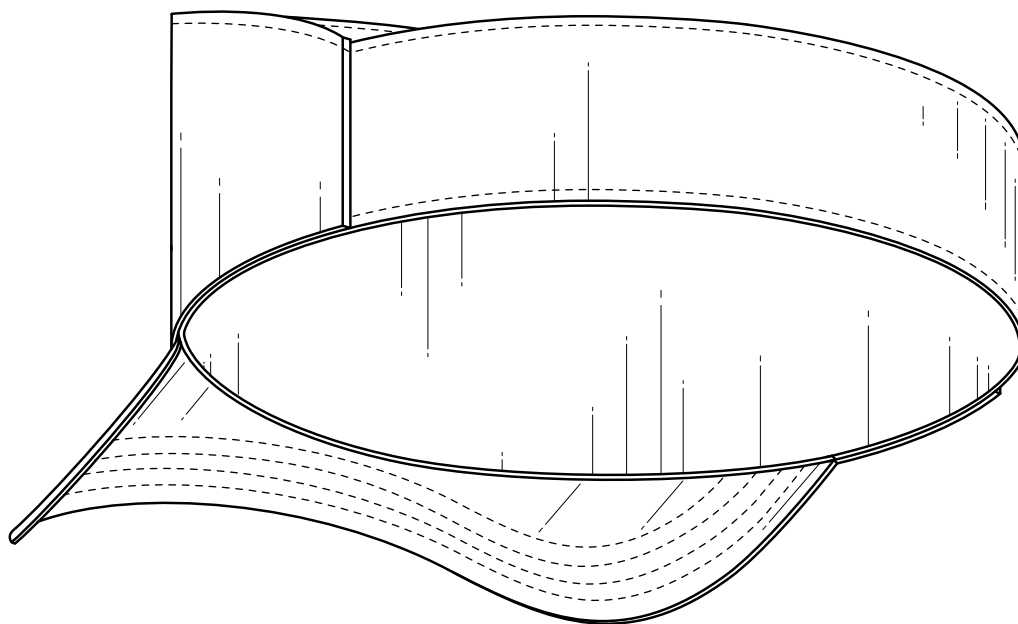

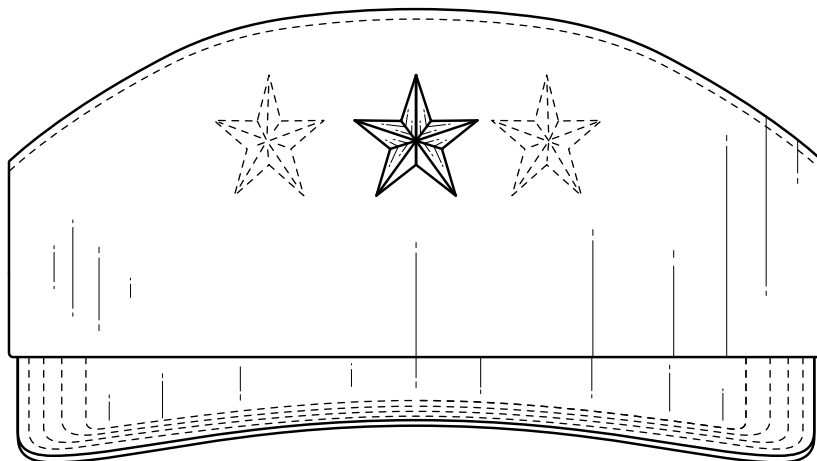

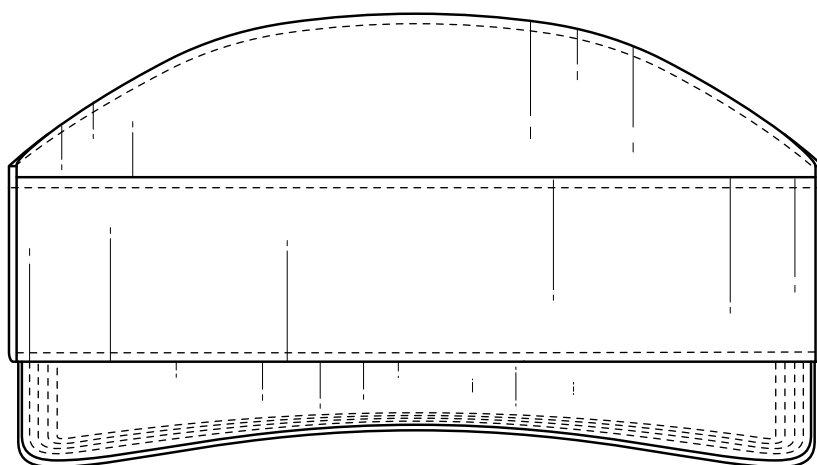

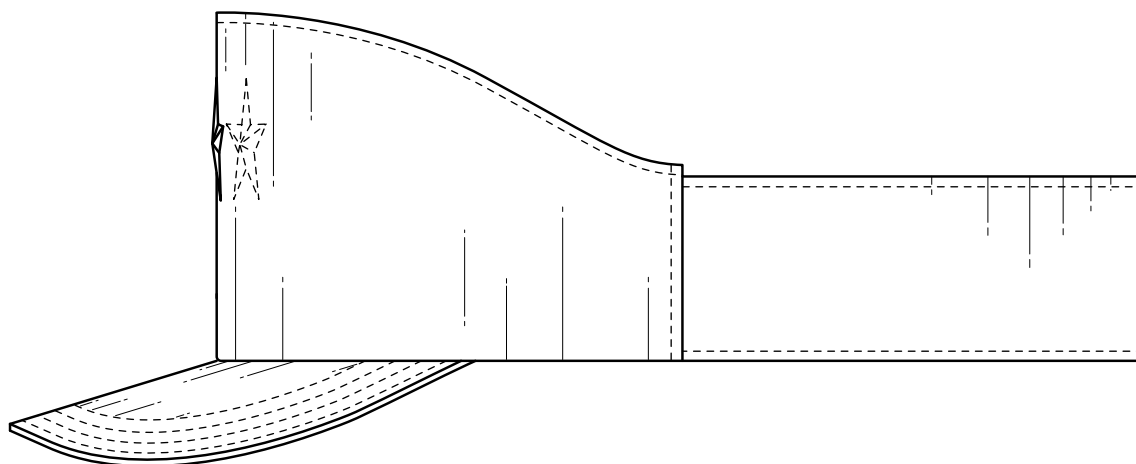

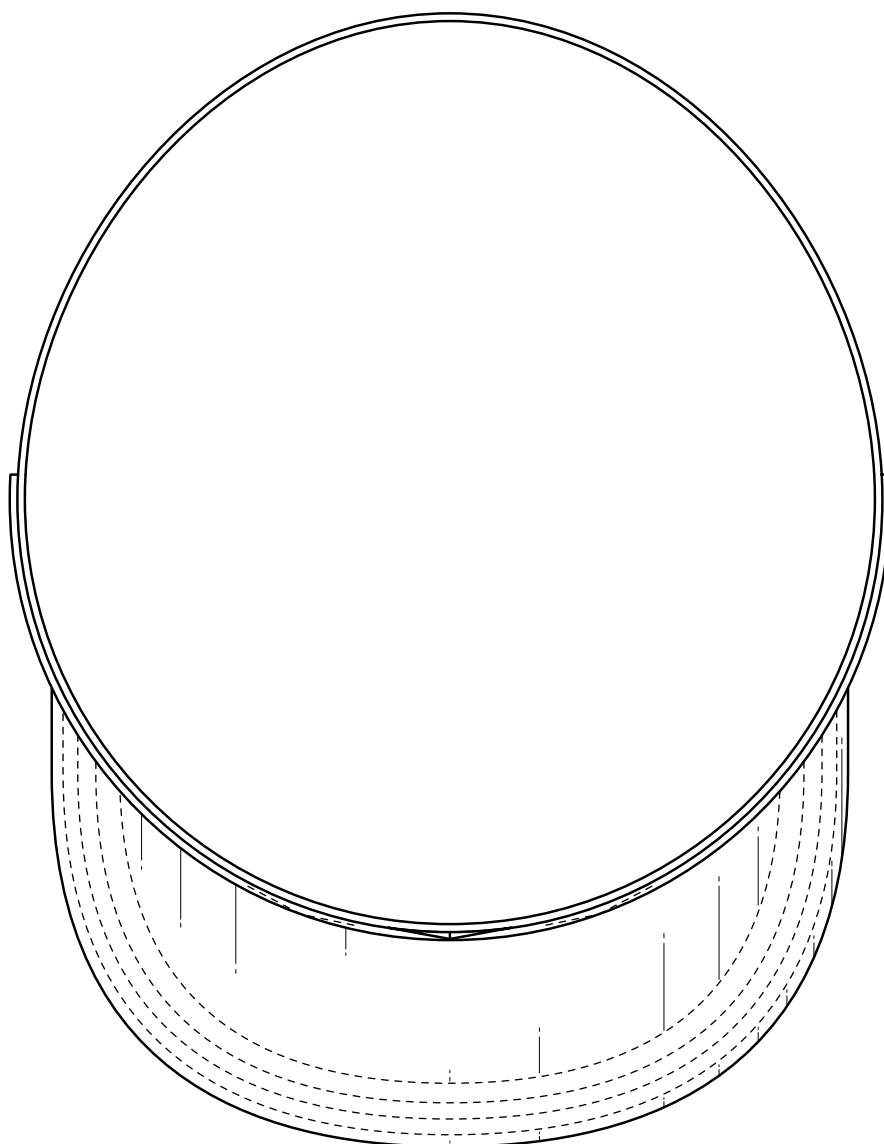

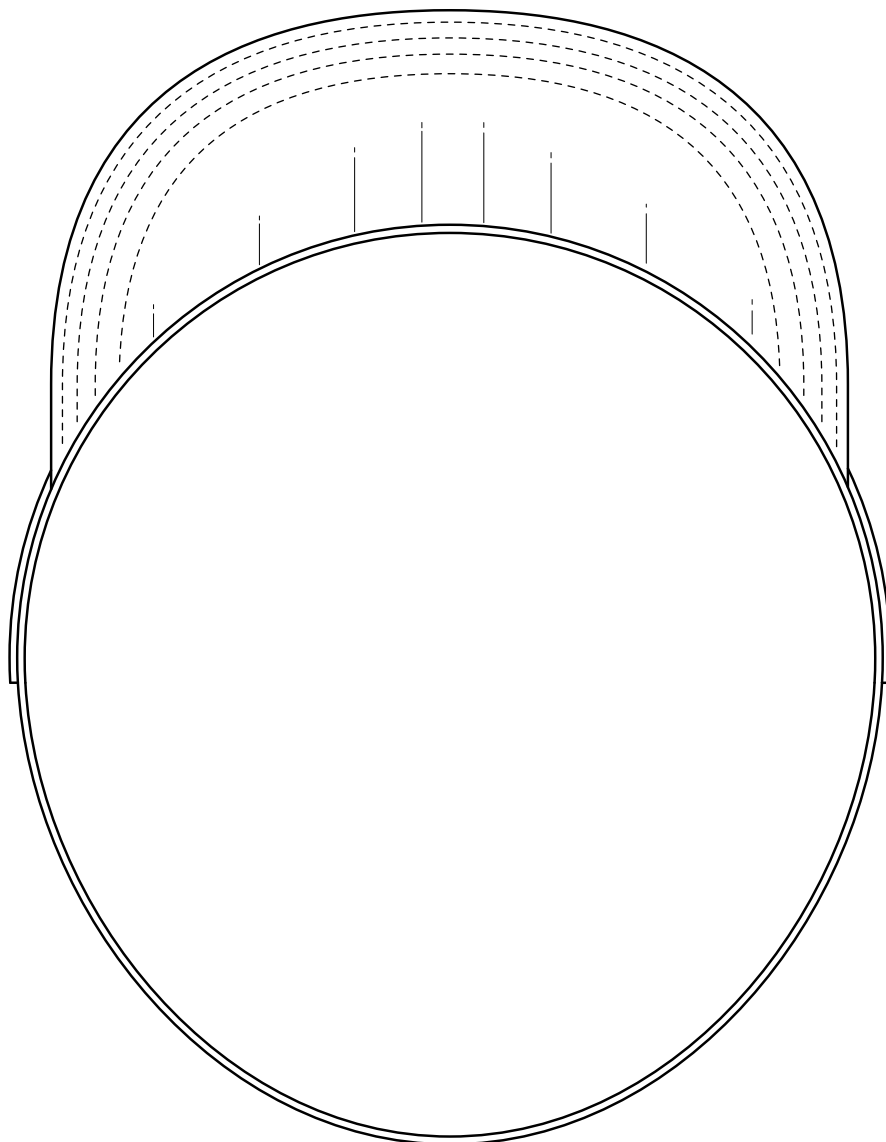

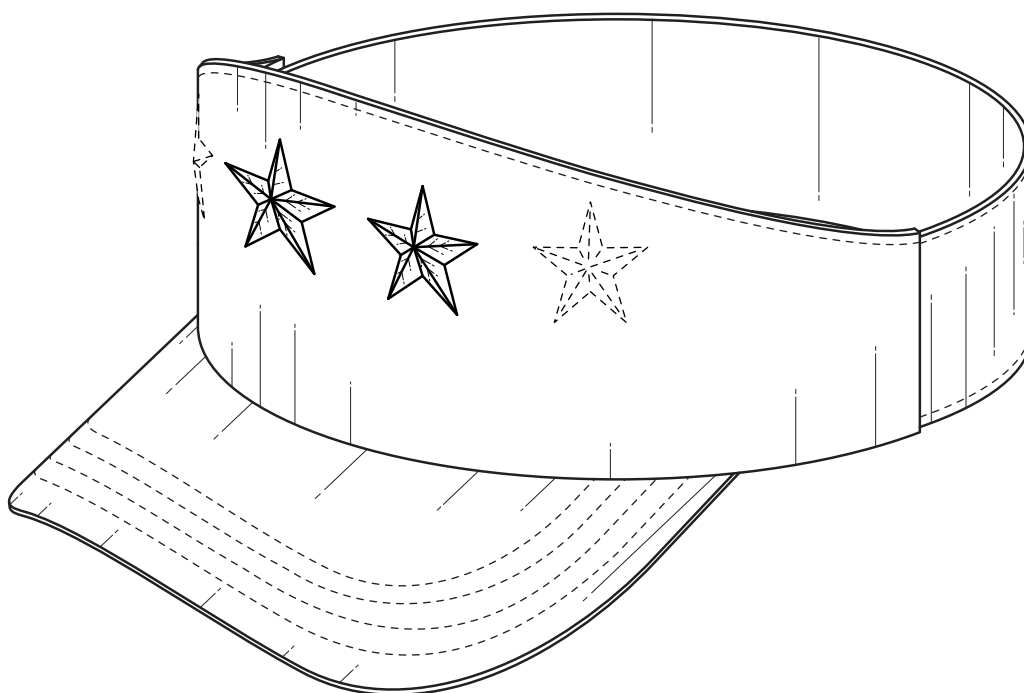

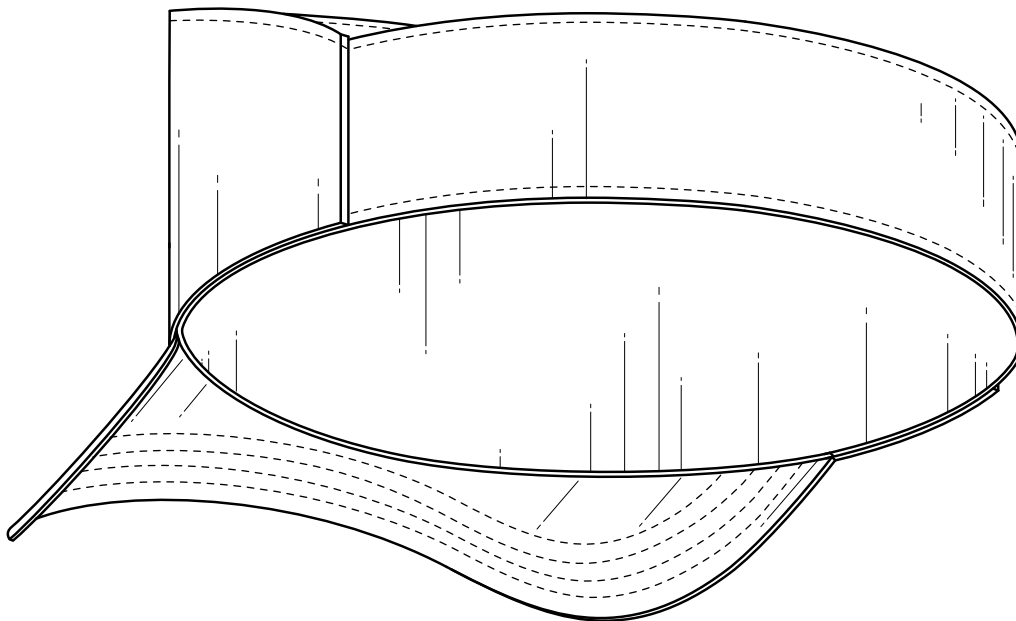

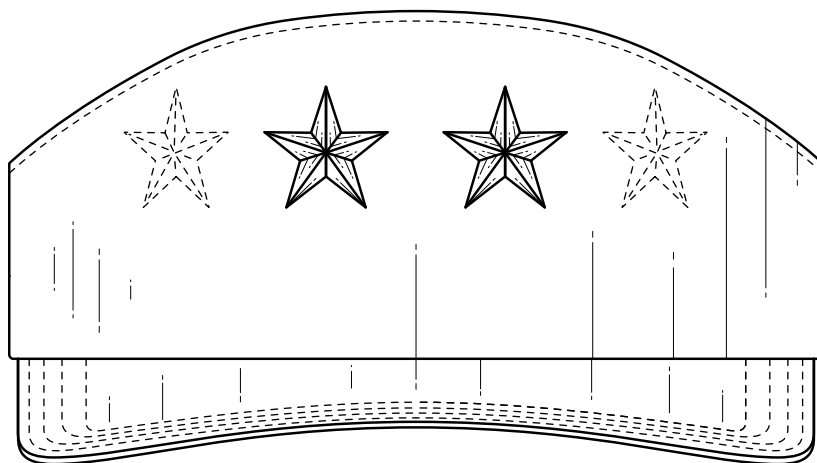

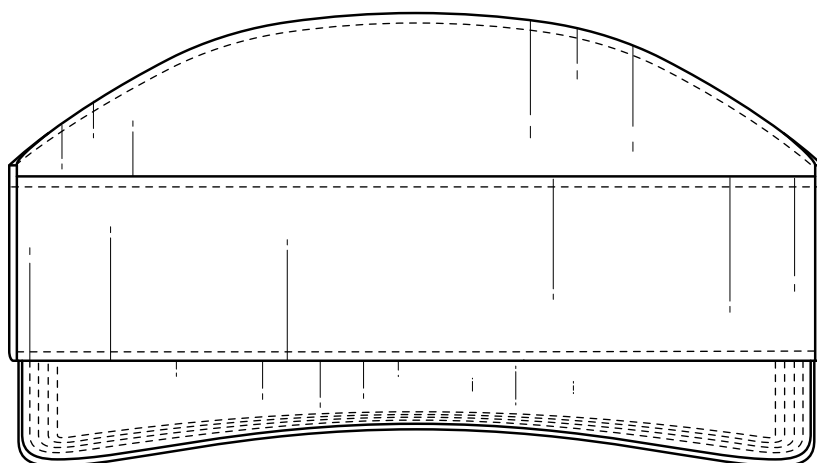

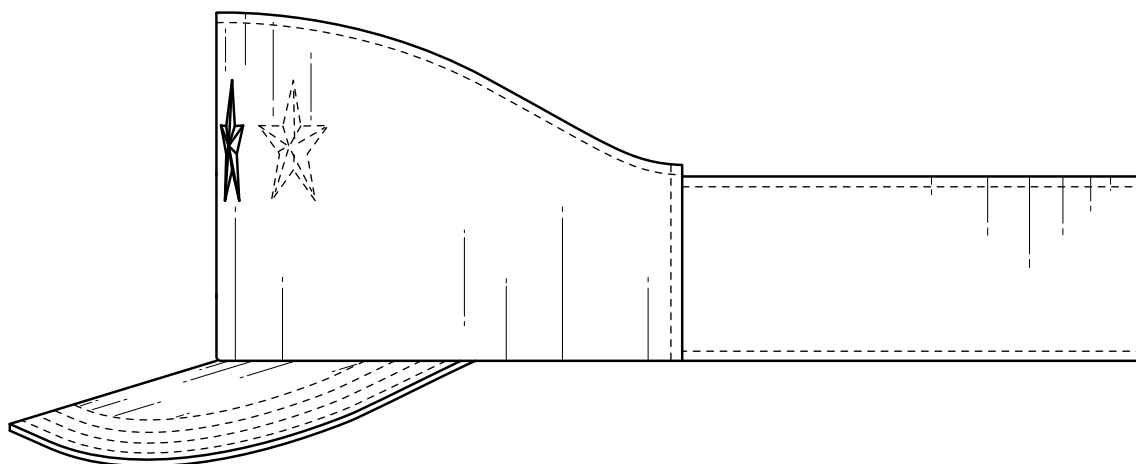

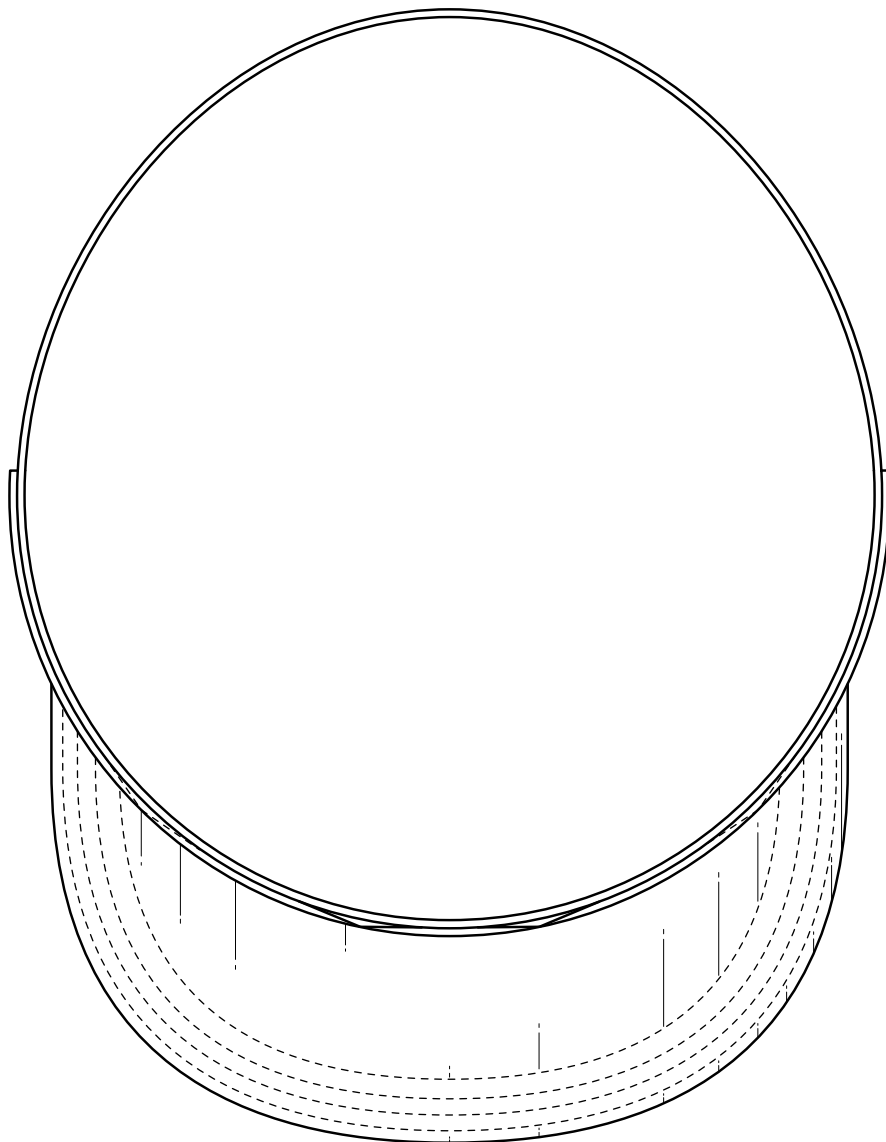

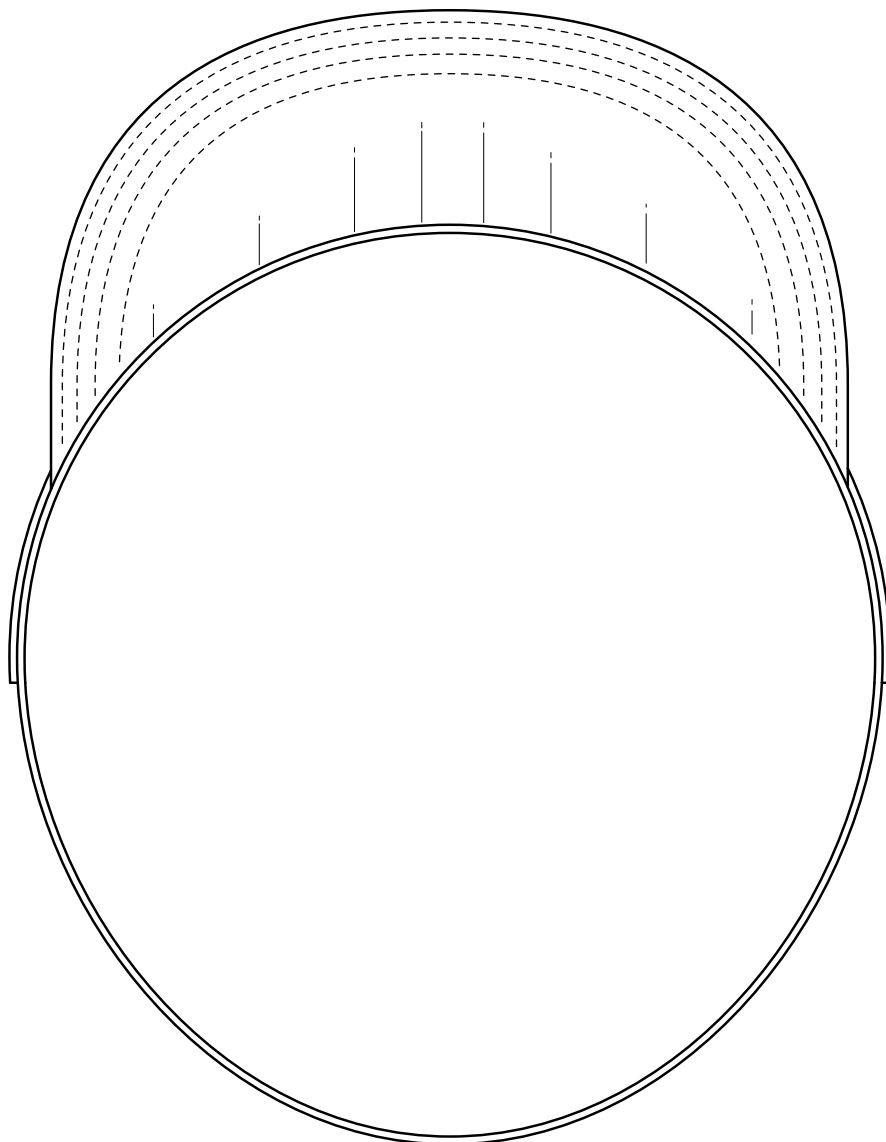
